### **Academic Integrity Policy**

#### **Introduction**

Academic integrity is essential to building a fair, respectful, and honest learning environment. For our young learners in the PYP, this means understanding and practicing honesty in all aspects of their learning journey. Students, teachers, and parents/guardians work together to create a culture of trust and responsibility, ensuring that the work produced is authentic and reflects individual effort.

#### **Principles**

**The PYP community is expected to:**

- Act honestly and fairly in all learning activities.
- Submit original work that reflects their own thinking and creativity.
- Respect the ideas and work of others by giving credit when using their contributions.

**Students are encouraged to:**

- Use books, websites, and other resources responsibly.
- Acknowledge the sources of their ideas, pictures, or any other borrowed materials using simple methods (e.g., “This picture is from [source]”).
- Work collaboratively only when permitted and ensure their contribution is authentic.

#### **Academic Malpractice**

Academic malpractice in the PYP refers to any behavior that compromises honesty and fairness. Common examples include:

- Copying: Using another's work or ideas as your own without acknowledgment.
- Collusion: Allowing others to copy your work or working together when not allowed.
- Misrepresentation: Pretending someone else's work is your own.

## **Roles and Responsibilities**

### **School Leadership Team:**

- Create and maintain a supportive environment for academic honesty.
- Provide resources and training for staff to instill academic integrity values.
- Communicate the importance of academic integrity to parents and guardians.

### **Teachers:**

- Model integrity by giving credit to resources and ideas during teaching.
- Teach students how to acknowledge sources using simple, age-appropriate methods.
- Guide students in distinguishing between their own ideas and borrowed ones.
- Design learning activities that promote authentic work.
- Provide clear guidelines and examples of acceptable practices.

### **Students:**

- Complete all assignments with honesty and effort.
- Respect others' work by acknowledging the source of borrowed ideas, pictures, or information.
- Work collaboratively only when allowed by the teacher.
- Ask for help when unsure about academic honesty expectations.

### **Parents/Guardians:**

- Support the school's academic integrity policy.
- Encourage honesty and fairness at home.
- Reinforce the importance of completing assignments authentically.
- Guide children to seek help from teachers when they encounter challenges.



## **Teaching Academic Integrity Skills**

The school ensures that all students understand academic integrity through age-appropriate instruction:

### **Grade 1-2:**

- Understand basic concepts of honesty and fairness.
- Recognize the importance of honesty and giving credit for others' work.
- Learn to explain where a picture, idea, or story came from.
- Develop simple referencing skills (e.g., "This idea is from [book/website]").

### **Grade 3-4:**

- Develop simple referencing skills (e.g., "This idea is from [book/website]").
- Understand what is allowed in group work and collaboration.
- Learn to avoid copying directly from books, friends and website. Write it in your own words.

### **Grade 5:**

- Practice evaluating resources for credibility and relevance.
- Write simple bibliographies with guidance (e.g., listing books and websites used).
- Develop an understanding of plagiarism and how to avoid it.

## **Offenses and Consequences**

If a student is found engaging in academic malpractice:

- The teacher will discuss the issue with the student, explaining why the behavior was inappropriate.
- The student may be asked to redo the assignment authentically.
- Parents/guardians will be informed if the issue persists.
- The focus will remain on teaching and learning rather than punishment.

## **Reference Format**

At the PYP level, students use a simplified referencing system, guided by teachers and librarians. For example:

### **Grade 1**

#### **Print Resources**

Books: Book Title.

Magazines: Magazine Title

Encyclopedias: Encyclopedia Name

Websites: Article Title. Website Title.

### **Grades 2-3**

#### **Print Resources**

Books: Author, Book Title, page number

Magazines: Author, Magazine Title, page number

Encyclopedias: Author, Encyclopedia Name, page number

Websites: Author, (Article Title. Website Title.), page number

### **Grades 4-5**

#### **Print Resources**

Books: Last, F. M. (Year). \*Book Title\*. Publisher.

Magazines: Author Last, F. M. (Year, Month Day). Article title. \*Magazine Title\*.

URL (if applicable)

Encyclopedias: Author Last, F. M. (Year). Article title. In \*Encyclopedia Name\* (edition, if applicable). Publisher. URL (if applicable)

Websites: Author Last, F. M. (Year, Month Day). Article title. \*Website Title\*. URL

Accessed: Month Day, Year.

## 学术诚信政策

### 一、引言

学术诚信是构建公平、尊重、诚实学习环境的基石。对 PYP 阶段的学习者而言，这意味着理解并在学习全过程践行诚信原则。学生、教师与家长/监护人需携手创建信任文化，确保课业成果真实反映个人努力。

### 二、基本原则

PYP 社区全体成员应：

- 在所有学习活动中保持诚实公正
- 提交体现个人思考与创意的原创作品
- 尊重他人成果，使用外部素材时明确标注来源

学生应做到：

- 负责任地使用书籍、网站等资源
- 用简易方式标注引用来源（如“此图片来自[来源]”）
- 仅在允许情况下开展合作学习，并确保个人贡献的真实性

### 三、学术不端行为

PYP 阶段学术不端行为包括但不限于：

- 抄袭：未经授权使用他人成果
- 共谋：允许他人抄袭或违规合作
- 盗用：冒用他人作品

## 四、角色与责任

### 1.校领导团队：

- 创建支持学术诚信的环境
- 为教师提供相关培训与资源
- 向家长传达学术诚信重要性

### 2.教师：

- 示范规范引用行为
- 教授适龄的引用方法
- 指导学生区分原创与引用内容
- 设计促进原创的学习活动
- 提供清晰的行为范例

### 3.学生：

- 以诚信态度完成课业
- 尊重他人学术成果并规范标注引用内容
- 仅在教师允许时开展合作
- 对存疑事项主动寻求指导

#### 4.家长/监护人：

- 支持学校学术诚信政策
- 在家庭环境中倡导诚实守信
- 鼓励孩子独立完成课业
- 引导孩子遇到困难时寻求教师帮助

### 五、学术诚信技能培养

学校通过适龄化教学确保所有学生理解学术诚信。

#### 1-2 年级：

- 理解诚实与公平的基本概念
- 认识诚信的重要性及尊重他人劳动成果
- 学会说明图片、观点或故事的来源
- 学会说明素材来源（如“这个想法来自[书籍/网站]”）

#### 3-4 年级：

- 掌握引用方法（如“这个观点引自[书籍/网站]”）
- 明确小组合作中的行为准则
- 避免直接照搬书籍/同学/网络内容，学会用自己的语言表达

#### 5 年级：

- 实践评估资源的可信度与相关性
- 在指导下完成简易参考文献（如列出使用的书籍和网站）
- 建立对抄袭的认知并掌握规避方法

## 六、违纪处理

如发现学生存在学术不端行为：

- 教师将与涉事学生面谈，说明其行为不当之处
- 学生可能被要求重新独立完成作业
- 若问题持续存在，将通知家长/监护人
- 处理重点始终在于教育引导，而非单纯惩戒

## 七、参考文献格式规范

在 PYP 阶段，学生将在教师和图书管理员的指导下使用简化引用系统，例如：

1 年级：

图书：《书名》

杂志：《杂志名》

百科全书：《百科名称》

网站：文章名，《网站名》

2-3 年级：

图书：作者，《书名》，页码

杂志：作者，《杂志名》，页码

百科全书：作者，《百科名称》，页码

网站：作者（文章名.《网站名》），页码

4-5 年级：

图书：姓，名首字母，（年份），《书名》，出版社

杂志：姓，名首字母，（年月日），文章名，《杂志名》，网页地址(如有)

百科全书：姓，名首字母，（年份），条目名，《百科名称》(版次)，出版社，网页地址(如有)

网站：姓，名首字母，（年月日），文章名，《网站名》，网页地址访问日期，年月日

## 八、政策修订与审查

每学年开学初，在相关领导成员的监督下，由委员会进行审议。该政策实行年度审查机制，以确保其持续符合 PYP 教育社区的发展需求，并为师生提供有效支持。
